POLICE NON-EMERGENCY NUMBER 101
Only call 999 in an emergency, when a crime is in progress or life is in danger.

Incidents of Interest:

- Inc 57 – 04/04** – An attempt was made to gain entry to a garage on Poplar Road, Napton. Between 03/04 at 19.15hrs – 04/04 at 07.30hrs offender/s have removed a window but nothing appears to have been stolen.
- Inc 42 – 04/04** – Unknown offenders have gained entry to a garage on Manor Road Harbury. Between 22.00hrs on the 3rd April and 06.00hrs on the 4th April. Offender/s have entered a rear garden and forced the garage doors. A Yamaha and Aprila have been removed by unknown means.
- Inc 123 - 09/04** – Burglary dwelling Southam Football Club. Suspects unknown between 10.00hrs Saturday 7th April and 09.00hrs Sunday 8th April. Offenders have approached the football club and broken into the Bowling Green, offenders have caused damage to the lawn. The offenders have then forced entry to the Youth teams club and caused damage.
- Inc 145 – 10/04** – At approx. 01.37hrs on 10th April offender/s entered the garden of a property in Southam Road, Long Itchington. The victim has been alerted by the offenders trying the door handle, offender/s have made off.
- Inc 75 – 17/04** – Commercial Burglary. Between 19.00hrs on Monday 16th April – Tuesday 17th April at 07.30hrs Offender/s have gained entry to a commercial property in Westfield Road Southam. Cash and electrical equipment were stolen.
- Inc 55 -19/04** A car key burglary occurred in Wulfstan Drive, Long Itchington. Offender/s entered through a window and taken a set of car keys belonging to an Audi. Suspects have then driven off in the Audi.

Inc 68 26/04 relates to theft from motor vehicle where a builders van was entered. It is suspected that the incidents are related.
- 306 – 26/04** an attempt burglary occurred at a barn near Farnborough offenders were unable to gain entry.
- 350 – 30/04** Burglary dwelling. Sometime between 17.00hrs and 18.00hrs on Monday 30th April offender/s forced entry to a property in Farnborough. The victim disturbed the offender/s who made off in a small black car.
- 376 – 30/04** sometime between 27th April and 30th April offenders have caused damage by spraying paint on property in Priors Marston.
