ALCESTER

- *Suspicious Circumstances. Conway Fields, Alcester. Man seen to be trying to hide something in the river, and then hiding himself in the bushes. Caller not entirely sure what he was up to. Area checked by police – no trace. 8am Friday 6th July. 0095 06/07/2018
- *Suspicious Circumstances. Gunnings Bridge, Alcester. Caller reporting a man acting suspiciously in the area. Man was looking at the caller and whistled at them to get their attention. Caller concerned he was hanging around and waiting specifically for them. His behaviour made the caller feel uneasy. Described as a white male, 30's slim build, wearing smart trousers and shirt. 11am Wednesday 4th July. 0470 04/07/2018
 - *Theft. Store, Alcester. Theft of Wine, three pieces of beef steak, gammon joint and a leg of lamb by way of shoplifting. Totalling £50. Offender described as a white female, 5' 6", slim build, blond hair tied up, wearing light blue jeans and a grey top with the 6 on the back. She walked out of the store with the items still in a basket and did not offer payment. She walked into the car park where she gave the items to a man waiting outside. He is described as a white male, 5' 10", slim build, dark cropped hair, wearing a black vest and carrying an Adidas shoulder bag. The man also had a dog with him.  - *Attempt Burglary Residential. Kinnersley Road, Alcester. Rear door checked after an alarm activation. Door bent slightly at the top. May have been the result of the heat during the day, but there was a mark on the doorframe that could not be accounted for, so being treated as an attempt burglary at this time. 12.45am Monday 2nd July.  - *Theft, Store, Alcester. Seventeen bottles of alcohol stolen by way of shoplifting. Totalling £537. Male offender has entered the store with a trolley and several reusable bags. He has selected the bottles, putting them in the bags before covering them up with crisp packets. He has then left the store with the bags without offering payment. Described as a white male, late 20's, muscular build, 6', wearing dark shorts, white t-shirt with LeCoq Sportif design, Tattoo on left arm and brown hair which was gelled back and faded at the sides. 3pm Sunday 1st July. 0247 03/07/2018
