Incidents of Interest:

16 / Monday 9th July 18 – A burglary has been reported in Sandown Close. A property has been entered via small window, left open for pet access. Whist inside an Xbox has been stolen. No witness or CCTV available.

82 / Tuesday 10th July 18 – Report from an address on the Loxley Road that in the early hours a male on a cycle has ridden onto the drive way and has attempted to entre a vehicle parked on the drive. CCTV shows the male on site and enquires are ongoing.
