Between 0900 4/5 - 1800 the battery from a John Deer tractor was stolen.

Between 2300 08/05 and 0600 09/05 a Fiat Ducato, white, Swift motorhome has been stolen by unknown means.

Overnight 28/5 and 29/5 there has been extensive and senseless damage caused within the grounds of the church. Headstones have been pushed over and moved. This has naturally caused a great deal of upset within the community and especially to the families directly affected..

271—30/05/2019 Kineton Rd, Southam

Outbuilding broken into and Bosch drill, driver and various bits stolen. Main property also entered and a Toshiba camera and memory card with old movies stolen.

024- 31/05/2019 at approx. 0200, Station Fields, Fenny Compton

Two males wearing balaclavas climbed over fence and stole a chain saw and hedge trimmer.

There have been several reports of the theft of vehicle registration plates from across the area. You may wish to consider fitting anti-theft number plates screws which are available commercially.
